

ORDINARY TRANSIT **(TYPE B – TRANSIT)**

- A valid national passport / travel document in which a visa can be affixed with proof of UK Residency / Immigration status.
- A visa application form duly filled in and signed together with two recent photographs bearing a true likeness to the applicant.
- Valid entry visas for the country of transit / destination.
- Proof of transport arrangements via Belgium only. (Confirmed Airplane / ferry bookings).
- Applicants traveling by car are requested to provide the Car Insurance, Car Registration, and Ferry Booking.
- Proof of a Hotel Reservation or a Letter of Invitation.
- Proof of sufficient and regular personal financial means (recent 3 months salary slips, bank statements and/or income tax papers, if applicable).
- Declaration Consent for Minor children from both Parents.
- Proof of a valid Overseas Travel Insurance with your name and covering dates.

Important:

1. *The documents listed above are only the basic documents to be submitted in all cases. Additional documents may be requested by the Embassy and applicants could also be invited for an interview.*
2. *All submitted documents must be recent (within the last 6 months). Submitting false documents may be followed by legal action.*
3. *The Embassy may ask for verification of financial documents provided from the corresponding bank/financial institution.*
4. *The above mentioned type 'C' visa is for valid for all Schengen countries and is intended for a short stay up to 90 days.*
5. *Please provide the copies of all the originals documents. The documents sent to the Belgium Embassy would not be returned.*
6. *Please take a photocopy of the first page of your passport prior to your submission at the Belgium Visa Application Centre.*
