

FAMILY REUNIFICATION TO JOIN PARENTS (TYPE D – LONG STAY)

Child of a Belgian citizen or a European Economic Area (EEA) National who resides in Belgium.

- A valid national passport / travel document in which a visa can be affixed with proof of UK Residency / Immigration status.
- Two visa application forms duly completed, signed and accompanied by two recent passport photographs bearing a true likeness to the applicant.
- A certified copy of your birth certificate.
- A certified copy of the divorce certificate of your parents or death certificate of your parent, as applicable.
- Declaration Consent from Parent or Guardian to leave home country.
- A copy of the Belgian Passport /Identity Card or Residence Permit of your Parent residing in Belgium.
- A Prosecution/Conviction History document or Police Clearance not more than six months prior to the date of application and covering the last five years if you are above **21 years**

If you are the Child of an individual who is not a national of a country in the European Economic Area (EEA).

- A copy of the Belgian Identity Card, Confirmation of Registration (attestation d'immatriculation/attest van immatriculatie) or residence permit of your Parent residing in Belgium who is a non-Belgian citizen or an EEA national.
- A Prosecution/Conviction History document or Police Clearance not more than six months prior to the date of application and covering the last five years if you are above **18 years**.

Important:

1. *The documents listed above are only the basic documents to be submitted in all cases. Additional documents may be requested by the Embassy and applicants could also be invited for an interview.*
2. *All copies of official documents should be certified and not more than 6 months older than the date of application for the visa.*
3. *The Embassy may ask for verification of financial documents provided from the corresponding bank/financial institution.*
4. *The above mentioned type D visa is a one entry national visa and requires registration in the Belgian population registers on arrival.*
5. *Please take a photocopy of the first page of your passport prior to your submission at the Belgium Visa Application Centre.*
6. *Applicants are requested to carry 2 sets of photocopies along with all the documents in original.*
7. *Please take 2 sets of photocopies of the first and last pages of the passport as well as those pages containing Home Address and the UK visa.*
